

Early College Vs. Dual Enrollment

There are several ways to earn college credit while in high school. Early college and dual enrollment are two different ways high school students can early college credit it. Both programs provide college classes and cover the cost of tuition, fees and books up to \$725.00 per class. Any amount in excess of this is the student's/family's responsibility. Although these programs are very similar, they also have some very distinct difference. You do not have attend either program if you do not want to.

Must attend early college program for three years – 11 th , 12 th and 13 th grade required	No 13 th grade requirement/option
Must attend Early College of Macomb @ Macomb CC	Can attend any public community college or university
Associate's Degree/credits earned after three years	Maximum of 10 college classes allowed by the end of 12 th grade
Does not work with Anchor Bay Honors Academy	Works with Anchor Bay Honors Academy
Must attend Macomb CC after 3 rd hour in 11 th grade	Students leave ABHS for college as needed
Must attend Macomb CC after 2 nd hour in 12 th grade	Maximum allotment is \$725.00 per class, including the price of books
Must attend Macomb CC one year after high school	Any high school student can attend regardless of grade level
Can take in-person, remote, or online college classes	Can take in-person, remote, or online college classes
No transportation provided to college	No transportation provided to college
Students must leave ABHS during scheduled college hours	Students must leave ABHS during scheduled college hours
High school diploma given to student upon early college exit, not at high school graduation	High school diploma given to student upon high school graduation

Early college and dual enrollment students always have six total class periods each semester. If you attend either program, tell your counselor which classes you'll take at the high school and which classes you'll take at the college. If you decide to go to early college, you must take three classes at the high school and three classes at the college in 11th grade each semester. Dual enrollment does not have a minimum class requirement each semester, but has a maximum of 10 college classes by the end of 12th grade.
