#### Good evening,

As we approach the end of the school year, it is a very exciting time, especially for our seniors. - No unexcused absences during 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (Final attendance check will be made at the end of the day – Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>)
- No more than 10 total absences during 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (does not include court or medical notes)
- No suspensions (for any reason) during 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (Final suspension check will be at the end of the day – Monday, May 20<sup>th</sup>)

  - If seniors are exempt from only 2<sup>nd</sup> hour, they can hang out in the commons (they are not to be in the halls or other classrooms)
- If seniors are exempt from all exams, they do not attend school (please call your child's absence in)
  - Seniors cannot attend a class unless they have a final exam
  - Seniors taking an exam must remain in class until the period is over (they cannot leave early from class when they are done with an exam)
