THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN SCHEDULING:

- ***SPANISH I / 8th GRADE ELECTIVE** - It is recommended that band students consider taking Spanish I as their 8th grade elective. - **HIGH SCHOOL FINE ARTS GRADUATION CREDIT** - If band is continued at the high school level, it will fulfill the Fine Arts Credit required for high school graduation.
- **SUCCESS IN SCHOOL** - It is widely documented that musically trained students are more invested in their schooling, achieve higher GPA's, and perform better on standardized tests (like the SAT) than their non-music peers.
- **UNIQUE LEARNING EXPERIENCE** - Playing an instrument in class every day works the brain differently than the core subjects. It builds self-confidence, increases the sense of accomplishment, improves communication skills, cultivates creativity, fosters responsibility & self-discipline, develops social skills, and creates a lifelong appreciation for music and the arts.

THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN SCHEDULING:

- **MARCHING BAND** - If a student takes the Marching Band Class for three (3) years, the class will exempt/replace the one-semester physical education (PE) credit requirement. Because the class takes place in 7th hour, it allows marching band students to take an extra one-semester class during high school.
- ****BAND IN 9th GRADE** - Those student that take one full year/credit of a band class (i.e. band in 9th grade), will fulfill their one-credit Visual, Preforming, and Applied Arts graduation requirement.
- ***FOREIGN LANGUAGE** - Band students are able to exempt/replace the second year of their foreign language requirement by taking a second year (one credit) of a band class. Students can also take a foreign language in 8th grade to meet one credit of the high school requirement. This allows opportunity for other electives or even a second band class (i.e. jazz ensemble). Check your college's requirements (all are different).
- **PLEASE NOTE** - Students do not need to be in the Honors Academy to take AP and Honors courses. The extreme is represented above. Most students take a schedule that is similar, but slightly less demanding.
