IMPORTANT SAFETY CONCERN - #1

Doors do not open until 8:55 AM for students. Please do not drop off students early! If you wish to let your students out of the vehicle before 8:55, please park in a parking spot and walk to the building with your students to wait for the doors to open.

Remember that SAFETY is our number one concern when dropping off or picking up your student. With the weather getting warmer, people are picking up their students to rush home to enjoy some time outside. Be patient and alert when in the drop off or pick up line. **DO NOT cut out of line to bypass others.** This heightens the risk of someone being hit by a moving vehicle in the parking lot. Please take a moment and look again before moving.

If there is a change in pick-up plans, please let the teacher and office staff know. Those picking up students must be on their Emergency Card.

IMPORTANT SAFETY CONCERN - #2

Remember that SAFETY is our number one concern. When entering the building to drop off or pick up your student, please scan the QR code to sign them in or out. If needed, press the intercom button to talk to the office staff. They will ask you who you are picking up and call them down for you, and you can have a seat and wait. If you need to come into the office area to discuss something with the staff or drop off medication, they will open the door once you state the reason for your visit. Please be patient while we follow the district protocol in keeping your students safe and sound! Thank you!
