What is JROTC?

Attention Incoming Freshman!

Students who complete all four years of AFJROTC can use a personal curriculum to be exempt from the following graduation requirements:

- 0.5 Health credit
- 0.5 PE credit
- 1.0 year Science elective credit (third-year)
- 1.0 Visual Performing Arts credit
- 1.0 Social Studies credit (except Government)
- 2nd World Language credit
