Superintendent Contract	<b>Motion</b> by Mr. Green to approve the finance committee's recommendation addendum to the Superintendent's contract to develop a three-year structure of a 6% increase to base salary and a 1-point increase to the annuity for each year provided the superintendent is rated effective or higher. For background, while Anchor Bay is the 46 <sup>th</sup> largest district by enrollment in Michigan, current contract places the superintendent at 113 <sup>th</sup> in salary which is approximately \$50,000 below his predecessor and below the market average. This addendum will increase the salary from \$165,000 to \$174,900 and can result in similar increases in future years if rated effective or highly effective or the next two years. This total is approximately two-tenths of one percent of the district budget.
