# SAFETY FIRST

Here are some of the steps we will be taking to keep Room 6 happy and healthy:

- 1) All frequently used surfaces will be disinfected with a 3 step process several times a day.
- 2) Staff and children will wear face masks when traveling through common areas.

In the classroom, staff will wear face masks; it is optional for children to wear face masks in the classroom.

- 3) All toys will be disinfected daily.
- 4) Seating and cubby assignment will be staggered when possible.
- 5) Children and staff will wash their hands upon entering the classroom, before transitioning to another activity, and throughout the day when necessary.


