team.

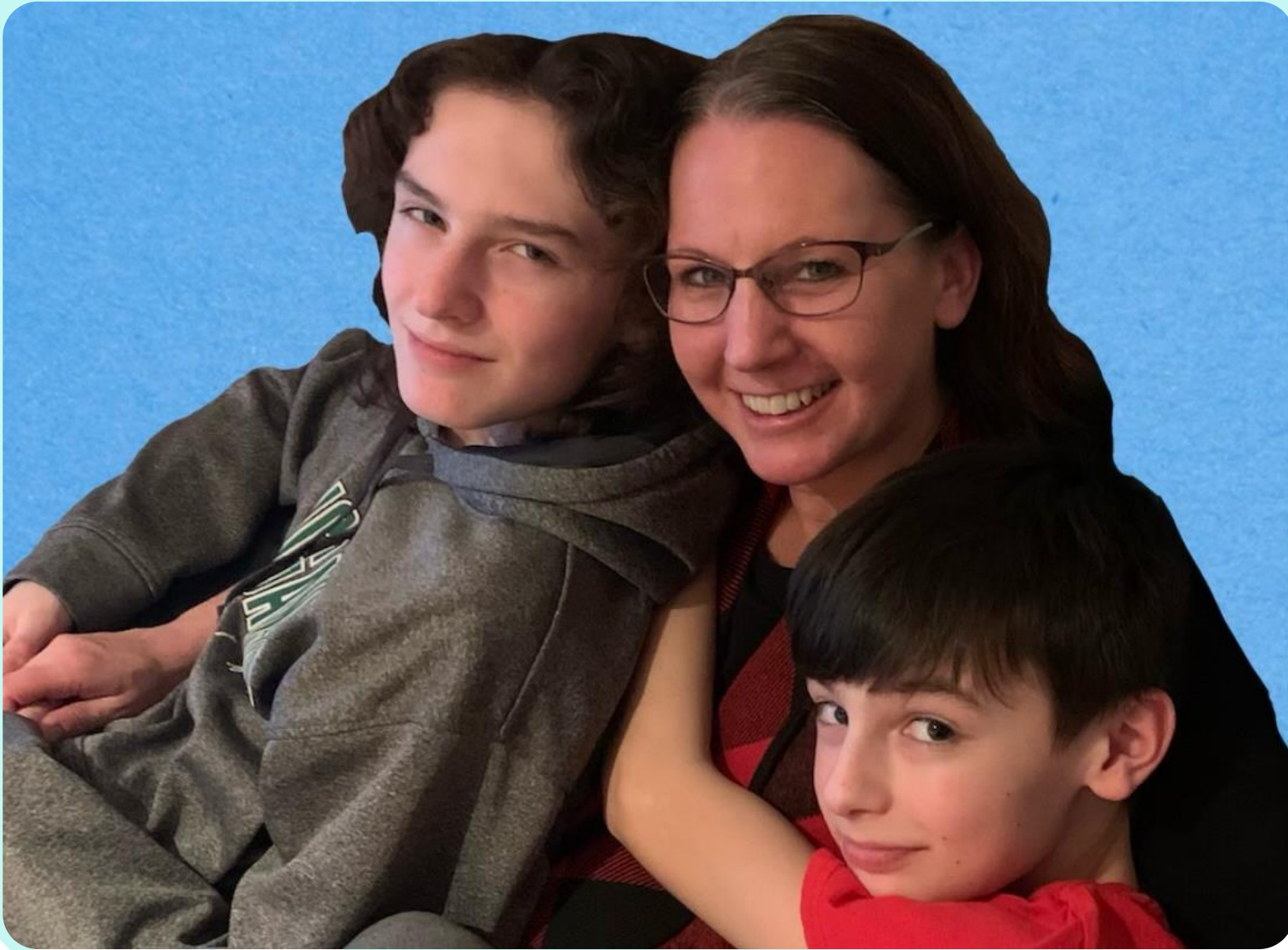


Meet the Teachers
