

Good afternoon. In preparation for SAT testing April 10<sup>th</sup> , junior **students will be completing the Digital Readiness Check in their English classes the week of 3/18**. This check is to ensure that Bluebook is working correctly on the Chromebooks, students are able to sign into Bluebook, their information listed in Bluebook is correct, including accommodations, and to complete exam setup. The Digital Readiness Check should take no more than 10-15 minutes to complete.

In order to sign-on to Bluebook, students will need a testing ticket. This will be given to them by their English teacher. After the Digital Readiness Check, students are encouraged to take their test ticket home to complete the test preview and the full-length practice test.

Included in the DRC is an opportunity to sign up for BigFuture School and Connections. BigFuture School is a free mobile app that lets students view their scores and get customized career information and guidance about planning and paying for college. Available through the BigFuture School app, Connections™ is a free program exclusively for school day test takers that allows them to hear from nonprofit colleges and scholarship programs that may be a good match. If you would prefer that your student not sign up for BigFuture School and Connections, please fill out the opt out form below. Filling out the form allows you to opt your student out of providing optional information that is not directly related to the administration of these assessments. **This form will close 11:59pm on Friday, March 15<sup>th</sup> .**
