Please know that our upcoming Spring 2024 State Testing is both, a State of Michigan requirement, and also an Anchor Bay High School graduation requirement. **All students will be registered to test.** This includes face-to-face students, virtual/remote students, as well as all dual enrollment and early college students. **It is required that all tests be administered in-person at ABHS.** All tests begin at our normal, school start time. Breakfast will be available if interested. Busing will be available to all testers. The table below indicates what test(s) your student(s) will be required to take in April.
