- The boys' track and field team raced passed Chippewa Valley and Grosse Pointe North yesterday in a double dual meet. The wins put the team in first place in the MAC Red division. Outstanding performances were turned in by the three Tar captains. Jonah Konarz, who won both hurdle races, ran on the 800 meter relay that beat GPN and tied for first in high jump. Thomas Westphal won the 800 and 1600 meter runs. Aiden Champagne was also a member of the 800 meter relay and finished 2nd in the 400 meter dash and 3rd in the 200 meter dash. The 3200 meter relay team of Zach Rubicz, Aidan Leslie, Greg Vogt and Aaron Osterman finished first. The Tar throwing team also provided a big lift by sweeping Chippewa Valley in the shot put and taking first and third in the discus. Winners were Matthew Grawburg in shot and Cameron Gramzow in discus. Mitchel Morrison won the pole vault and Ethan Usery placed second. The Tar distance runners will compete at the Elaine Leigh Invitational at Oakland University Friday then will send a partial team to the Royal Oak Relays on Saturday.
