ONLINE ENROLLMENT & ANNUAL REGISTRATION SYSTEM

NEW STUDENTS

New K-12 Resident and Schools of Choice students will use the pre-registration link located on the district homepage.

This online process will replace the paper enrollment and Schools of Choice application process. If you do not have access to a phone or computer to fill out the forms, a time can be scheduled to come in and fill out the forms at one of our buildings.

Steps:

1. Click the link to fill out the pre-registration form for new K-12 resident students and new School of Choice applicants. Current GSRP families will be given their access code to enroll for kindergarten.
2. You will receive an email confirmation that your pre-registration was received.
3. Please allow 7-10 business days for approval. We will be verifying the information you submitted on the form.
4. Once approved, you will receive an email to create your parent portal account to access the online enrollment forms.
5. Enrollment forms for your new student will be found in your parent portal.
6. Fill out the enrollment forms online. Required documents can be uploaded in the Parent Portal or you can schedule a time to drop off required documents including birth certificate, vaccination records, etc. to your building or the administration center.

GSRP will NOT use this online registration form. Please call the Early Childhood Center at 586-716-7862.

ECSE families need to call Special Services at 586-949-4513 for approval before doing the online enrollment process.

EXISTING STUDENTS

All Returning Students

All existing Anchor Bay students will use the online process for returning to school in the fall! Parents will need to log into their parent portal account and fill out "Annual Update" forms for their students. These forms will replace the paper forms that were sent home at the beginning of the school year to confirm items such as emergency contacts and health conditions.

It will be required that every student have these forms filled out by their parent/guardian. We anticipate that this process will start in late-July. We will send out a SchoolMessenger and post information on our website and social media accounts.

Make sure you can log into your Parent Portal account and have access to all your students!

ATHLETICS

Please visit <https://www.abtars.com/landing/index> for details. Beginning with the Fall 2023 season, Anchor Bay Athletics will be transitioning to a new student-athlete registration software. The new software, Student Central, will replace Appryse. Prior to participating in sports at Anchor Bay High School, all students and parents are required to register in our online registration system Student Central prior to the first day of practice or tryouts.

For the 2023-24 school year, an MHSAA pre-participation sports physical is required for all students who participate in sports. A physical examination must be completed on or after April 15, 2023 to be considered a valid physical for 2023-24. A blank MHSAA Physical Card/Medical History Form can be provided by your health care provider or downloaded by using the link (<https://www.mhsaa.com/sites/default/files/2022-06/physical2page.pdf>). Instructions on how to register through Student Central can be found below.

1. Visit <http://www.planeths.com/>
2. Both parents and students are required to create separate accounts. Begin by setting up the student's account first by selecting Sign Up to Create New Account. Enter student information.
3. Once on the home page of the student account, click Link Parent Account. Enter the phone or email address of the parent and an invitation, including instructions on how to create an account, will be sent. Follow the instructions provided to link student and parent account.
4. In the student account, follow the instructions for reviewing athletic forms. Four forms must be completed - MHSAA Physical Evaluation Form (scan both pages and upload as a PDF file), Parent/Athlete Concussion Form, Student-Athlete Code of Conduct Signature Form, and the Athletic Consent Form.
5. Once in the parent account, accept your student's invitation to link accounts, then complete the Review Athletic Forms section. The Physical Evaluation Form will be (1) approved by the Athletic Department or (2) denied by the Athletic Department and will need to be resubmitted with corrections made. Notifications will be sent by email or can be viewed in your account.
6. Once forms are reviewed and submitted, complete the Emergency Contact Section.

ACT Work Keys Information:

- Students can view their scores online and print their own National Career Readiness Certificate starting July 7, 2023 by creating their free account at myworkkeys.com (www.myworkkeys.com).
- Students will provide the following five matching criteria when creating an account: First name, Last name, Month of birth, Day of birth & State Assigned

Student ID Number (SASID).

- The SASID is the same as the student UIC number.

Important FALL 2023 Testing Information:

- All Juniors (11) will be registered for the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (NMSQT) next October.

Important SPRING 2024 Testing Information:

- State mandated testing will begin the week of April 8th (SAT w/Essay, ACT Work Keys, PSAT 10 & PSAT 9). Please use this information to plan vacations around this very important assessment time for your student(s).
- Juniors (11) will complete the Michigan Merit Exam. (MME). The MME has three components: the SAT with Essay, the ACT Work Keys, and the M-Step (Science & Social Studies). Completion of all components is required for graduation from ABHS.
