## Parking Pass Application and Driving/Parking Contract

2022-2023 School Year

Parking a vehicle in an Anchor Bay High School parking lot is a privilege that is earned and maintained by the student. No parking pass will be issued if a student has an outstanding student debt or has a history of parking/driving violations.

Here's what is needed to apply for a Parking Pass:

- completed application (requires parent signature)
- valid driver's license
- current vehicle registration for ALL cars listed (expired paperwork will not be accepted)
- valid proof of insurance for ALL cars listed (expired paperwork will not be accepted)
- payment (online payment via Local Level (preferred), cash, checks (until March 4)

## Fees:

\$40: passes purchased during Registration/1st Quarter

\$30: passes purchased during 2nd Quarter

\$20: passes purchased during 3rd Quarter

\$10: passes purchased during 4th Quarter

\$5: passes purchased during the last two weeks of school if you are authorized for free or reduced lunch, the fee will be half the original cost

- drive recklessly
- o am involved in an accident on campus

- have passengers who behave inappropriately
- commit gross negligence
- o disregard the directions of school personnel

Parking passes can be temporarily or fully revoked (with no refund issued) if the rules governing driving/parking in school lots are violated.
