- Possibly Panera Bread for December. It was brought up to have it on a Friday or Saturday because everyone will be holiday shopping.
- Gymnastics Days these are lumped in with restaurant nights. Last year, we had 1 date with 73 kids attending. There are 3 dates booked for this school year. It was decided to keep all 3. The goal is to have 100 kids attend each date. This will be open gym with a ninja course 2-4pm on the following Saturdays: February 17 (during winter break), March 16, and April 13.

 - This event will again be free for all Lottie families, but the form will have a spot for donations
 - Waiting to hear back from Bigby about coffee and hot chocolate
 - Jamie offered costumes for Grinch, Olaf, gingerbread man and Christmas tree. She will wear one. Just need 3 more volunteers to wear the others.
 - Cookies will be from BJ's Warehouse. Just approximately \$0.10 more per dozen than Gordon Foods, but they are pre baked and ready to go.
 - Donation wish list will be combined with Santa shop
