 - Next order will be the beginning of school (Sept/Oct) There will be a bigger time frame to place an order and to get the word out
 - •Raise Right: Jamie Freeman
 - It's all set up with a Lottie PTO account
 - There is an app to download on your phone or you can use the website
 - There is a very minimal service fee to buy from the site
 - NO physical gift cards
 - Anyone can use it, so share with family and friends
 - Buy gift cards and print or email them to be used
 - PTO will get % of sales. Every store has a different percent and some days are special days for certain stores and they will give a higher percent that day/s
 - A flier with a QR code was created ad will be posted on the Lottie PTO facebook page, sent home with students and put in the Lottie Line up
 - Movie Night: Marjorie Benac
 - This was another free event for Lottie Families
 - 6:30-8 pm was a great time (after dinner)
 - Total attendance was 74 children and adults
 - Budget: \$200 total cost: \$107 (movie, popcorn from GFS, water, fruit snacks, backdrop, glow sticks and 3 raffle prizes)
 - Thank you to committee and volunteers for set up/clean up

 - •raised almost \$1,500
 - only 1 issue with an order, but it was resolved quickly
- Popcorn Days (Emily)
 - •A couple more dates are coming up
 - •There is a increase in cost at Gordon's for the supplies, so next year the budget will need to be raised
- Literacy Night (Emily and Marjorie)
 - •Committee is already set, but if you want to join see Marjorie
 - •Mrs. Sacker would like us to do gift baskets again this year
 - •May not be able to get high school volunteers because it is career night at the high school
 - •We need to purchase ice cream and topping for the ice cream social and may need to help with serving
