Dear Parent/Guardian of future seventh grader:

The State of Michigan requires children to be age-appropriately vaccinated to enroll in school programs, unless a valid exemption applies^{*}. Children entering 7th grade are required to have documentation of the following vaccinations:

- ✓ 5 doses DTap and 1 dose Tdap
- ✓ 4 doses Polio
- ✓ 3 doses Hepatitis B, or laboratory evidence of immunity
- ✓ 2 doses MMR, or laboratory evidence of immunity
- ✓ 2 doses Varicella, laboratory evidence of immunity, or written statement of varicella disease history from a parent/guardian or physician.
- ✓ 1 dose ACWY Meningococcal Conjugate

Get Required Vaccines

Or Get Valid Exemption for Vaccines

* Parents must provide the school with one or both of the below two valid exemptions.

- Non-medical Immunization Waiver Form The local health department must certify this type of waiver for religious or other objection(s) to vaccine(s). To obtain a certified nonmedical waiver, a legal guardian must schedule an appointment by calling 586 466 6840 and receive an education on the vaccines waived. See "<u>How to Obtain a Nonmedical Waiver</u>" instructions (also included).
- 2. Medical Contraindication Form This type of waiver is completed by a physician (MD., or DO.) verifying a medical reason that prevents the child from receiving a specific immunization(s) for a specific period of time. This form can be found on the website link below.

Any child with a valid exemption (medical contraindication or nonmedical waiver to a particular vaccination) is considered susceptible to that vaccine-preventable disease, and is subject to exclusion from the school if an outbreak of the disease occurs.

The State of Michigan Non-medical Waiver form must be utilized, issued & certified by a MI Local Health Department	In order to obtain a certified non-medical waiver form, the parent/guardian must receive an education on the vaccines waived from the Local Health Department. Parent must call the Macomb County Health Department (MCHD) School Immunization Program (SIP) at 586-466-6840 to schedule a waiver education session appointment. Parent must provide the following information in order to make the appointment: 1. Child's Name, Address, Birthdate and school/child care center name. 2. Guardian/parent's name. Parent(s) are responsible for providing the waiver to their child's school /childcare.

This form will be completed with the child's information. Registration Form: Parent signature on the registration form signifies that you are the parent/legal guardian of the child named on the registration form. You will have to sign one form per child if you are obtaining a waiver for more than one child. Follow up Instructions information on what to do with the certified waiver form. If you Choose Not to Vaccinate Your Child - information for each vaccine waived.
Waiver certification: The parent must sign two copies of each child's waiver, one for the parent to keep and the other will be retained for the SIP record.	 In order to certify the waiver, all fields must be completed including the parent's signature The parent who received the education is the only one that can sign the waiver form. Upon the nurse's request, the parent meets the nurse at the front door of the MCHD Parent signs the waivers and the registration form(s) provided by the nurse After the parent's signature, the nurse will sign & certify Waiver Forms The certified waiver will be given to the parent & a copy will be kept for the SIP records To minimize in-person contact, please have all your questions answered over the phone, have a mask on, bring a pen and expeditiously sign necessary paperwork.
Lost Waiver Form: Only In person & by appointment	If the parent/guardian loses the waiver , they will need to make an appointment with the MCHD to get another copy. <u>The parent that signed the waiver form is the only one that</u> <u>can schedule replacement pick up</u> . Photo identification must be provided to pick up a <u>copy of the waiver</u> .
